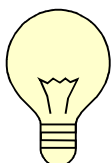
If you register for the 2<sup>nd</sup> 8 Week session during these times:

### Important Tip

Start planning for the 2012-2013 academic year. Make a note of priority dates for financial aid:

**Fall- June 1      Spring- November 1      Summer- March 1**

Priority dates provide time for processing and awarding financial aid before classes start. Be prepared to pay for tuition, fees, and books if financial aid applications are received after these dates.

**EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 7, 2011, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE START OF REGISTRATION FOR SPRING SEMESTER, STUDENTS WHO HAVE YET TO MEET THE CRITERIA STATED BELOW WILL BE RESTRICTED FROM REGISTERING THEMSELVES FOR COURSES ON WEB ADVISOR AND WILL BE REQUIRED TO ATTEND AN ADVISING SESSION WITH THEIR ASSIGNED ADVISOR UNTIL:**

- a total of 24 institutional credit hours (*excluding developmental education and non-degree coursework and courses transferred in from other colleges/universities*) are successfully completed with a grade of "C" or higher

**OR**

- a total of 18 credit hours are successfully completed with a GPA of 3.0 or higher
